ROUTE UPDATES ENGLAND NORTH-SOUTH CYCLE ROUTE

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Routes:

5: Durham - Middlesbrough

pages 59-60: The Tees Transporter Bridge is currently closed until further notice. You must use the alternative route as provided on page 59. So, after 18.0 kms choose the alternative route. At the end of the alternative route, it is easy and fun to have a look at the Tees Transporter Bridge structure. Note the visitor experience is also closed until further notice.

14: Ashbourne – Leicester

page 113: note the mileage indicators in the directions on this page don't match the mileage markers on the map. The mileage markers on the map are correct.

In the directions:

- 9.7 should read 10.1
- 10.1 should read 10.5
- 10.8 should read 11.2
- 15.1 should read 15.5
- 19.0 should read 19.3
- 19.2 should read 19.6
- 19.8 should read 20.4
- 20.3 should read 20.9

15: Leicester – Stratford-upon-Avon

page 122: There is a temporary fence between the 'unclassified road' and the new cycle path on the west end, which may be shut when you arrive. It is possible to bypass this fence by heading into the new housing estate just south of the new cycle path. There is an opening between the 'unclassified road' and the new housing estate about 100m to the east.

page 123: The new Lias Line cycle path between the Stockton Locks and the High Speed Train route under construction may already open in September 2022. Only stay on the old railway bed after 20.3 km if the signage of the National Cycle Network (route 41) is actually taking you there! Otherwise, keep using the signposted via the quiet road to Leamington (route 41, coming down from the railway bed at 20.3 km).

page 123: The crossing of the new High Speed Train route is likely to alter. With a crossing kept open for cycling, it is important to follow the cycle sign posts, wherever these may take you!
