Routes:

4: Harwich-Maldon

page 46: From the T-junction at 6.5 km you can now turn left onto a cycle path on the left side of the road, which continues up to the roundabout at 6.7 km.

page 47: The T-junction at 23.2 km is now a roundabout, with a cycle path on its south side. Use this cycle path to join the road of the first exit of the roundabout.

5: Maldon-Woolwich

page 56: At 3.0 km, a new cycle path on the south side of the road makes that you don't have to cycle on the road anymore. Simply use the cycle path crossings to get into the Fairlop Waters Country Park.

Services:

To avoid disappointments, we recommend making reservations at least 24 hours in advance for all accommodation, even for campsites! For some campsites, this is now compulsory. Please refer to the terms and conditions of the provider in advance and adhere to the rules of the provider!
